

GOD'S GIFT Mentoring



This school-based prevention program for 6th through 12th-grade girls focuses on building leadership skills and increasing self-esteem by addressing such topics as:

- † Faith-Based Life Skills
- + Self-Esteem and Self-Care
- † Goal Setting
- † Substance Abuse
- † Anger Management
- † Relational Aggression / Bullying between girls
- † Intimate Partner Violence / Domestic Violence
- † Healthy Relationships

SISTER TO Sistain

Sister to Sistah is a diversion program that provides a turning point for young women through interaction with community leaders and other positive role models that helps keep them out of the juvenile justice system.

This 8-week program gives participants (young women ages 12-18) an outlet to openly discuss relevant teen issues including self-esteem, healthy relationships and choices, nutrition, sexual assault, bullying, gang and violence prevention, and goal setting.

CAREER Seekers

The Career Seekers Internship Program recruits and matches middle school girls with female business professionals throughout South Florida for an 8-week professional development internship, where they will have the opportunity to explore a new career field, shadow their work-mentor, and gain a hands-on experience by performing character building and professional developmental various tasks. This eight-week career exploration program allows participants to identify their career interests, introduce them to professional interview techniques, and equip them with tools needed to succeed in today's workforce.

GIRLS' Day Out

Girls Day Out brings together 150 young girls from Fort Lauderdale for a day of growth, camaraderie, empowerment, and most importantly, to recognize International Day of The Girl. The event encompasses a wide range of activities, including yoga and mindfulness sessions to promote mental wellness, a thrilling 3-on-3 basketball tournament pitting participants against local female law enforcement officials, tug-of-war, kickball, relay races, and much more.

Girls Day Out goes beyond physical fitness; it's an occasion for young girls to bond, learn, and have fun in a supportive and empowering environment. This event aims to boost self-confidence, promote teamwork, and inspire the girls of Fort Lauderdale to achieve their fullest potential.




